ITINERARY

Day 1 (18 Nov 2019): Delhi/ Mumbai to Ma Sharanam Ashram (via Indore)

On reaching Indore Airport, depart for Ma Sharanam Ashram (2 hrs 30 min drive). which is situated just 300 mtrs from holy river *Narmada*. (*Ma Sharanam Ashram is a place to nourish your soul, deepens your spiritual practice, and awakens to your true self. It is a place for inner freedom.*) Tired of long journey, take rest and overnight stay at ashram.

Day 2 (19 Nov 2019): Ma Sharanam Ashram

Day begin with early morning Aarti, Yoga & Meditation.

Day to relax, feel spiritual vibration and get involved into ashram activities and surroundings.

Overnight stay at ashram.

Day 3 (20 Nov 2019) : Ma Sharanam Ashram to Omkareshwar (39 kms, 1hr)

Day begin with early morning Aarti, Yoga & Meditation.

After breakfast, will take you for a day trip to Omkareshwar. (*Omkareshwar is a Sacred Hindu place dedicated to God Shiva. It is one of the 12 revered Jyotirlinga shrines of Shiva. It is small island in the Narmada river; the shape of the island is said to be like the Hindu "Om" symbol.*) After reaching at ashram take some rest and get refreshed to participate in the evening rituals of the ashram. Overnight stay at ashram.

Day 4 (21 Nov 2019) : Ma Sharanam Ashram to Maheshwar (42 kms, day trip)

Day begin with early morning Aarti, Yoga & Meditation.

After breakfast, will take you for a day trip to Maheshwar. (*Maheshwar is the historical town with Maheshwar Fort, the Peshwa, Ahilya and Fanese ghats, Temples etc. and is also known for its distinctive hand-woven saris called Maheshwari. Maheshwar's temples and mighty fort-complex stand in quite beauty, mirrored in the river below.*)

After reaching at ashram take some rest and get refreshed to participate in the evening rituals of the ashram. Overnight stay at ashram.

Day 5 (22 Nov 2019) : Ma Sharanam Ashram

Day begin with early morning Aarti, Yoga & Meditation.

Day to relax, feel spiritual vibration and get involved into ashram activities and surroundings.

Overnight stay at ashram.

Day 6 (23 Nov 2019): Ma Sharanam Ashram to Ujjain (via Indore) 166 Kms

Day begin with early morning Aarti, Yoga & Meditation.

We will depart from Ashram at 8:00 am after breakfast for Ujjain. In between we will stop at Indore for Lunch. *(Ujjain, is an ancient city of Malwa region in central India, on the eastern bank of the Kshipra River. One of the twelve jyotirlingas in India, the lingam at Mahakaleshwar is believed to be swayambhu (born of itself) deriving currents of power (shakti) from within itself as against the other images and lingams which are ritually established and invested with mantra-shakti. The idol of Mahakaleshwar is known to be dakshinamurti, facing the south. This is a unique feature upheld by tantric traditions to be found only in Mahakaleshwar among the twelve Jyotirlingas.)* Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 7 (24 Nov 2019): Ujjain to Sanchi 237 Kms

Early morning at 6:30 am we will visit Mahakal Temple and after breakfast depart for Sanchi.

(Sanchi, having remarkable specimen of Buddhist art and architecture right from the early Mauryan period (c. third century BC to twelfth century AD). Sanchi is famous in the world for stupas, monolithic Ashoka pillar, temples, monasteries and sculptural wealth.

It was Emperor Asoka who laid the foundations of a religious centre at Sanchi fascinated probably by the location of the hill or because of his Queen Devi, who was the daughter of a merchant of Vidisha. He erected the Great Stupa (Stupa 1) here after redistribution of mortal remains of Lord Buddha for erecting several stupas all over the country in order to spread Buddhism. This stupa was originally a low structure of brick, half the diameter of the present edifice hemispherical in shape with raised terraces at the base. It was enclosed by a wooden railing and a stone umbrella at the top. This Great Stupa served as a nucleus to the large Buddhist establishment during the later period.) Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 8 (25 Nov 2019) : Sanchi to Orchha (via Bhopal)

After breakfast and some sightseeing we will depart to Bhopal. After having lunch at Bhopal we will go by train to Jhansi. (Shatabdi will leave Bhopal at 3:15 pm and reach Jhansi at 6:35 pm). From Jhansi we will go by cab to Orchha (approx 17 kms). Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 9 (26 Nov 2019) : Orchha

After breakfast, Orchha sightseeing.

(Orchha, that means a "hidden place", undoubtedly lives up to its name. It is an Architectural gems of Central India tourism. Its scenic beauty is very much photogenic. Orchha tourist attractions are of varying nature like fort, palace, cenotaphs, wildlife sanctuary, river bank, river rafting, village visit, temples etc. All these features at one destination, makes this place suitable to be called "hidden gem"

of Madhya Pradesh tourism. Gathered around the foot of the striking ruins, a sleepy village of efficiently painted houses and market stalls.

History of Orchha revolves around Bundela dynasty that ruled over this region of Bundelkhand. Orchha has an alluring different appeal. It too has a history & a history of Indian music & poetry. It is also a warehouse of medieval architecture not noticeable elsewhere. Once you are in Orchha, you are fairly in a dreamland of a hoary past, humming its mellow strain in the waves of Betwa River. The most captivating place in the Orchha complex is the two-storey brick construction, Rai Praveen Mahal in the garden of Anand Mahal. It was built by Raja Indramani. Rai Praveen, a multitalented singer & a woman of exceptional beauty was a paramour of Raja Indramani. The place has the other monuments of interest with fascinating beauty delicate carving on the niches are Chaturbhuj temple, Laxmi Narayan temple, Phool Bagh & the legendary Dinman Hardaul temple.) Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 10 (27 Nov 2019) : Orchha to Panna 198 Kms

After breakfast, depart for Panna National Park. (Panna National Park is a 22nd Tiger reserve of India and fifth in Indian central state of Madhya Pradesh, once this land was a private hunting land of the royal family of Panna until India's independence, and then the park was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1981. On 1994 this National park was upgraded into a Tiger Reserve with inclusion of some other wildlife sanctuary like Gangau WLS, Panna National Park & Ken Gharia wildlife sanctuary. Pandav caves in Panna is mentioned in the great epic of Hindus 'Mahabharata' that Pandavas spent a long time of their exile in this forest of Panna.

In addition to this, there are many other tourist places like Ken Gharial Sanctuary, Raneh Fall, Pandav Fall, Dhabela Museum, Ajaygarh Fort, Kalinjar Fort etc. Panna national park is know for its scenic beauty. It is the only national park in Central India which offers scenic water falls inside the park with varying bird species. Different vulture species, leopard photography and sloth bear photography are the major attraction among tourists doing jungle safari.) Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 11 (28 Nov 2019) : Panna

Local sightseeing and Jungle Safari in Panna.
Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 12 (29 Nov 2019) : Panna to Khajuraho (day trip) 41 Kms

After breakfast depart for day trip to Khajuraho. (Khajuraho is famous for its ancient temples that depict some of the finest art in the world. Built between 950-1050 AD by the Chandela Dynasty, these temples depict various forms like meditation, spiritual teachings, kinship, wrestling, royalty and most significantly, erotic art. The temples consist of stunning displays of fine sculptures and exceptional architectural skill, making them one of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites.) Overnight stay at Hotel.

Day 13 (30 Nov 2019) : Panna to New Delhi

Day begins to reveal all activity throughout the journey.
Depart for Khajuraho Airport (approx 40 Kms) for your onward journey for Delhi.
